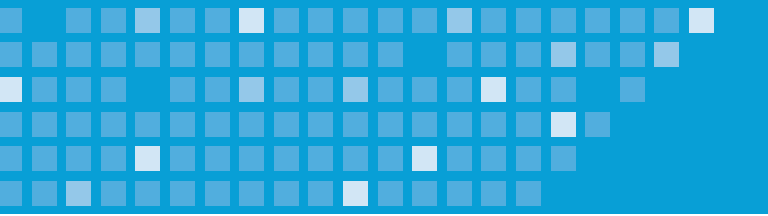

In addition, field offices are established for all long-term programs. ICMA texts have been translated from English into numerous other languages, including Spanish, Polish, Russian, and Hungarian. Providing access to up-to-date local government information, events, and publications in English and Spanish, the ICMA Web site (icma.org) is a resource for local government professionals around the world. ICMA's annual conference serves as a meeting point each year for thousands of members and local government professionals from around the globe, with 19 countries represented in 2005. ICMA staff, who come from more than 20 countries and speak 25 languages, ensure that our work is relevant and accessible to our colleagues.
